### **Food Service and Sales, and Nutrition Policy**

Oasis Charter Public School is participating in the National School Lunch Program. No school providing kindergarten or any of grades one through eight shall permit the sale of food by pupil organizations if such school is participating in the National School Lunch, School Breakfast, or Food Distribution program .

The school administration may permit an organization to sell food item per sale when all of the following conditions are met:

- (1) The specific nutritious food item categorized as a healthy option per the federal child nutrition program
- (2) The food sales do not begin until 30 minutes after the closing of the school day
- (3) The sales are not of food items prepared on the premises.
- (5) The food item sold is a dessert type food, such as pastry, ice cream or fruit.
- (6) The food item sold is not one sold in the food service program at that school during that school day.

#### **Birthday Food Policy**

If you want to serve a treat on your child's birthday it **MUST** be discussed and arranged with your child's teacher for the end of the school day. **ONLY** healthy snacks are allowed as a treat.

#### **COVID Restrictions:**

Due to the ongoing pandemic, **NO FOOD** is allowed as part of a birthday food treat (Example: No pizza, cupcakes, etc.). Instead, we are encouraging you to celebrate with goodie bags that include pre-packaged healthy snacks.
