Tobacco-Free School Policy

Oasis Charter Public School is tobacco-free school which prohibits all tobacco use anytime, anywhere by anyone on all school property, and at all school-sponsored events (California *Health and Safety Code* Section 104420 [n][2]). School property includes buildings, grounds and vehicles owned or leased by the school. School-sponsored events include sporting events, school dances and other events held on and off school property.

Oasis Charter Public School recognizes that the use of tobacco products, including electronic cigarettes, is a health, safety, and environmental hazard for students, staff, visitors, and school facilities. The Governing board is acutely aware of the serious health risks associated with the use of tobacco products, both to users and non-users. The Board embraces its obligation to promote positive role models in schools, and to provide an environment for learning and working that is safe, healthy, and free from unwanted smoke and tobacco use for the students, staff, and visitors.

It shall be a violation of this policy for any student of Oasis Charter Public School to possess, consume, display, or sell any tobacco products, tobacco-related devices, or electronic cigarettes at any time on school property or at off-campus, school-sponsored events. It shall be a violation of this policy for any staff, administrator, or visitor of Oasis Charter Public School to consume, display, or sell any tobacco products, tobacco-related devices, or electronic cigarettes at any time on school property or at off-campus, school-sponsored events.
